### PROJECT GOALS/OBJECTIVES

- Develop approaches to identify rhino horn trafficking network from Africa to Asia.
- Build commitment and capacity within law enforcement and judiciary in localities where priority criminals operate to catalyze effective enforcement actions.
- Hold local law enforcement and judiciary accountable at all steps along the enforcement process.



The Wildlife Conservation Society (WCS) saves wildlife and wild places worldwide through science, conservation action, education, and inspiring people to value nature. Over its proud 120 year history, WCS has significantly helped to advance wildlife conservation around the globe in partnership with governments and local communities. Currently, WCS has nearly 60 country offices worldwide, and the New York headquarters in the United States.





#### **KEY ACTIVITIES**

To achieve the overall objectives of the project, WCS - Viet Nam program focuses on the following key activities:

- Carry out activities to gather information on rhino horn trafficking network operating in Viet Nam and linked to other countries in Asia and Africa.
- Carry out training workshops and events with journalists, university graduates and selected law enforcement officers in Viet Nam to build capacity and interest in investigating wildlife trafficking.

#### EXPECTED OUTCOMES/FUTURE DIRECTION

- Dynamic threat assessment of suspected rhino horn trafficking in Viet Nam relating to some key countries in Asia and Africa.
- More than 100 enforcement and judiciary officers in Viet Nam directly engaged into the platform of workshops and training programs.
- A cultivated network of champions in key localities in Viet Nam who can take actions.
- A reliable, comprehensive system that provides a status update on all open cases of rhino horn trafficking related to Viet Nam.
- Increased probability of arrest, conviction, and effective penalty for crimes involving rhino horn in Viet Nam.



- Hold workshops, training programs and more informal meetings with local law enforcement in Viet Nam.
- Discover the champions in Viet Nam and provide them with on-the-job assistance.
- Track the progress of all criminal cases involving rhino horn trafficking and other high priority species linked to Viet Nam and Vietnamese people.
- Engage local and international media to build momentum on active cases or high-priority individuals.
